I hope this newsletter finds you well and healthy. Sickness has been running rampant in our household, but I think we are finally on the mend...

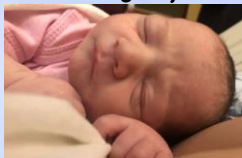
